Information Collection & Uses TYPES OF USERS

We have two different types of users of the site and it's services. The type of user you are will determine the collection and use policies of your information. The first type is a client. A client is a Enfinity Events customer that is using the services we provide to create a registration form for an event. They are a company or an individual using the software and services from Enfinity Events to run and manage an event. The other type of user is an attendee. An attendee is a person signing up for an event through a registration page created by our services and software by a client. The types of information collected and the use of that information is detailed below.

ATTENDEE INFORMATION COLLECTED BY ENFINITY EVENTS

All attendee data that is collected and maintained through our service is solely owned by the client, and we have no rights to sell or use the information provided. The client, not Enfinity Events, is

responsible for what information is collected and required on the registration forms. We will provide and maintain the secure storage of all information collected from the attendee and will not sell, use or rent the information collected to any third party.

CLIENT INFORMATION COLLECTED BY ENFINITY EVENTS

Clients purchasing service through Enfinity Events will be required to provide certain personally identifiable information. This will include personal information (such as name, email, phone, and shipping address) and financial information (such as credit number and expiration date). This information from clients is collected when a client signs up for a live demo, opens a new account, or calls and starts a new account over the phone.

The information collected is used for billing purposes and to send orders to the client or other involved third parties. Enfinity Events offers its online event registration service to clients as a means of collecting and managing attendee and/or vendor registrations. Any information provided on a registration page is the sole property of the client, kept on Enfinity Events's servers and is accessible only to the authorized client or to Enfinity Events at the direct request of the authorized client. If an attendee wants to find out how the client will be using their information the attendee should see the client's privacy statement or contact the client directly.

We do not link aggregate user data with personally identifiable information.
